Current Projects (as at Feb 2018)

The school was asked by the P&F for a list of projects that the P&F could consider assisting to fund. The following have been identified by the P&F as projects worthy of support.

1. Flexible Classroom Furniture	The school has a priority to upgrade very old desks and chairs to enable flexible space furniture. This furniture promotes a flexible and fluid teaching environment. Upgrades can cost up to \$30,000 per classroom. Between 8 and 10 classrooms have been identified for upgrading.
2. Storage shed for P&F and netball items	A new shed near the proposed \$200,000 court development has been identified as a useful addition to support the activities of the P&F and Netball club. Completed Jan 2017
3. Shade over the steps leading to the existing netball/ tennis courts	Shade in this area would benefit children and parents. Sun-safe grants may be available to assist here.
4. Portable Stage	The school and P&F would benefit from owning a portable stage for events such as the bush dance, fete and other school events. Cost is likely between \$12,000 and \$20,000. It is possible a grant will be available for this. Early 2018
5. Air-conditioning of the uniform shop	Air-conditioning would greatly help the working environment for these volunteers. A quote circa \$2,500 has been received. Completed Jan 2017
