

St Agnes Annual Goals By the End of 2019



By the end of 2019, 90% of students in Year 1 and 100% of students in Year 2-6 will have a conceptual understanding of Trusting the Count. This will be achieved through consistent monitoring and intervention for all students who do not have this concept by the end of Term 1.

By the end of 2019, 75% of Year 3, 80% of Year 4, 85% of Year 5 and 90% of Year 6 students will achieve the BCE benchmark, using the Writing Analysis Tool. This will be achieved by revising data in short term planning cycles to target specific elements of writing and by continuing to build staff capacity in the use of the Writing Analysis Tool with cross moderation between year levels.

We will embed a recontextualised Catholic perspective across the Health curriculum with a specific focus on relationships and sexuality.

We will deepen our understanding of St Agnes' school history and charism to rename our school sporting houses.

We will plan and conduct an Internal School Review in alignment with the National School Improvement Tool in order to prioritise areas of development.

We will continue to develop and refine practices associated with the use of ICTs in learning and teaching across all year levels to build digital capacity in staff and students.

We will create a culture that actively promotes activities and experiences to enhance student and staff wellbeing.

We will have developed a clear, integrated and documented Vision for Learning.

We will actively prioritise strategies for differentiation to promote student engagement and learning.
